The Zinc Mark is a leading quality assurance system to promote responsible production practices in the metallic raw materials industry and covers environmental, social, and governance (ESG) criteria. As part of this commitment, Boliden Odda AS will undergo an external, independent assessment from September 15 – September 19, 2025, to ensure that its operations meet the standards of The Zinc Mark.

The site will be assessed in the following areas:

- Environmental protection and sustainable use of resources
- Responsible sourcing of raw materials
- Human rights and labor rights
- Health and safety
- Community engagement and stakeholder involvement
- Business integrity and governance
